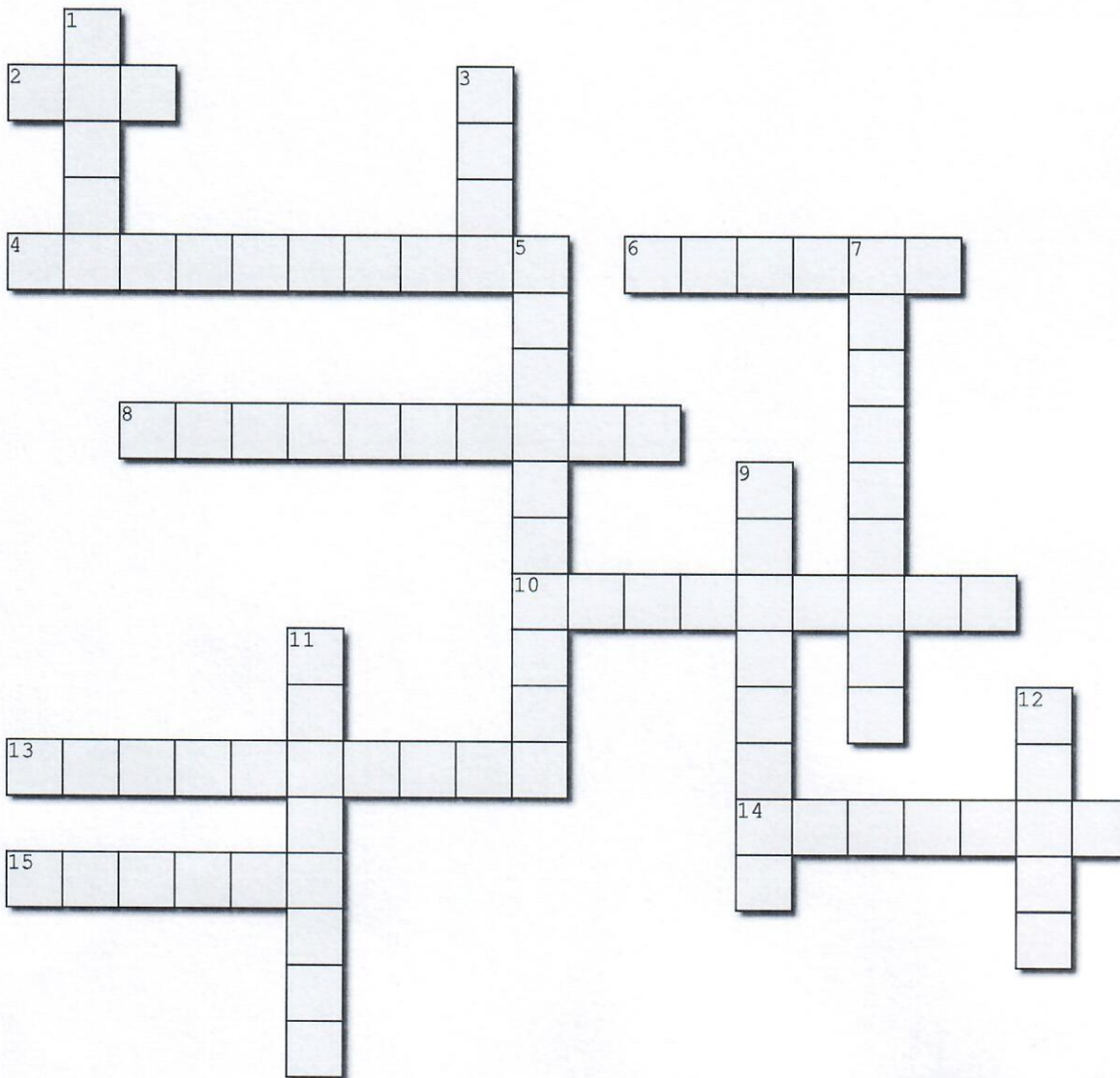


On Safari: Life with Animals Supplies to Take, Places to Visit

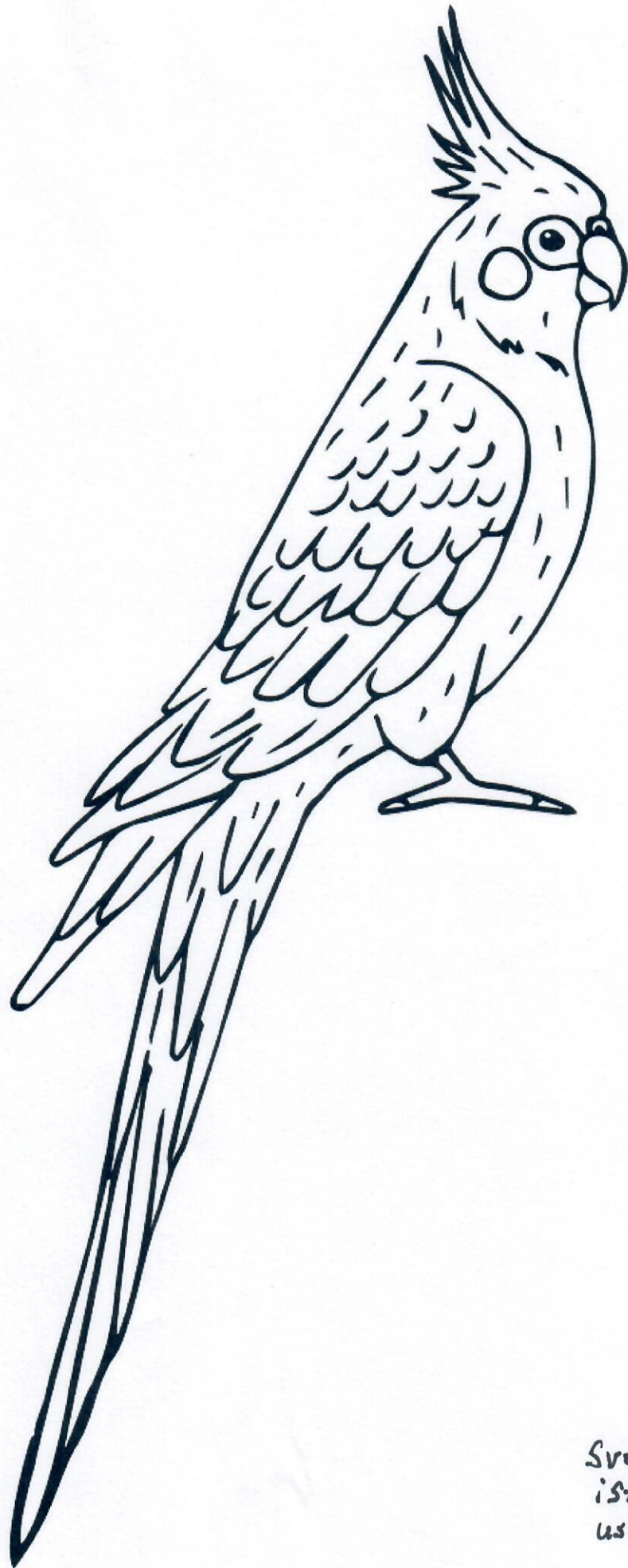

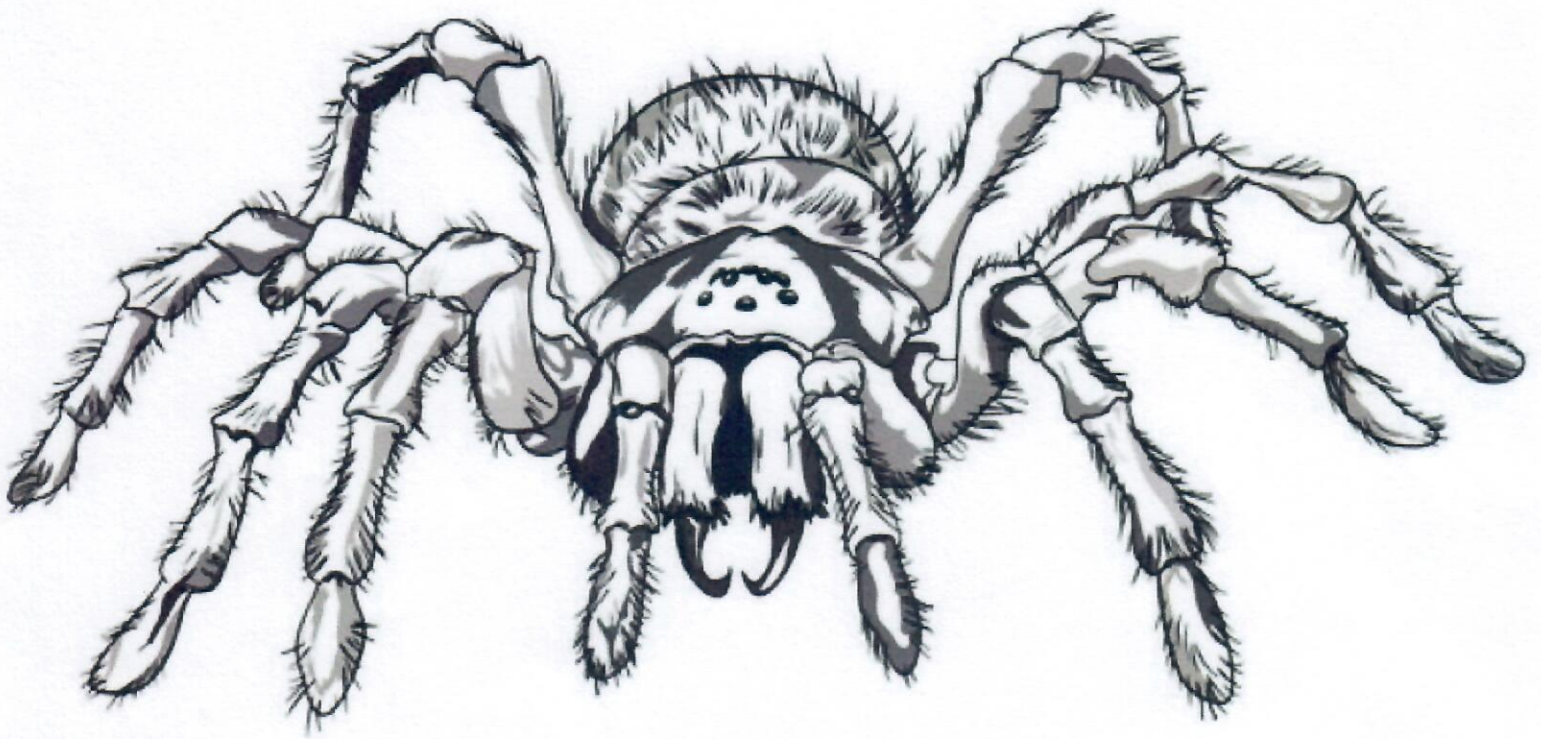
